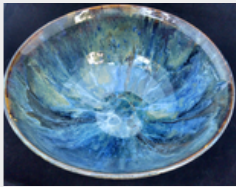
Statement I treat the Glaze process in a very painterly fashion. Many of the pieces are fired more than once to create the surface color and design I am looking for.
